

# Kindergarten Guided Reading Script

## Before reading

### Title:

- Talk to your child about the title of the story
- Ask your child what they think the story will be about and why?

### Orientation:

- Make it exciting!
- Talk about what is happening in the story and pictures

### Tricky words:

- Identity names or places that the child may find tricky
- Using 'window fingers' find a reoccurring word that would be helpful for them to see and say quickly

### Reading strategy:

- Remind students before reading the reading strategy they are focussing on. E.g. look at the pictures using your 'Eagle Eye'.  
*\*Look on reading tab on the website for examples*

## During reading

### Whilst reading:

You can:

- Make a reference to what is happening on the page
- Give them the first word in each sentence
- Give them prompts to help them work it out on their own, otherwise you can tell them the word

## After reading

### Model comprehension:

- Talk about what happened in the story e.g. wasn't it great that Jack kept trying and got to the tower.
